Hi everyone,

We may still be facing one of our so-called 'winters' over the coming two months, but it is already time to start planning for the upcoming Spring Show. Despite previous information to the contrary, our 2019 show is scheduled for the end of March. Setup will be Thursday March 28, judging will be on Friday, March 29 and the Show/Sale will be open to the public over the weekend (30-31 March).

At this time of year, you should have some potential show plants picked out. Try to find extra room for these plants. If you can grow them over the next two months avoiding the shading created by overlapping leaves from adjacent pots, you will have better looking plants at showtime.

We need to start organizing the committees that carry out the actual work of running the show. For the benefit of members who are not yet aware of the various committees involved, a list of committees is given

below. With some committees, a substantial number of volunteers are needed. For these committees, a brief description of the duties is given. The number of volunteers needed each day varies, so please, if a volunteer has already been identified to head a committee, contact that person for details.

Art: Chair Sharon Biddix-Maessen This show, we need to have volunteers who can help Sharon with a wide array of actions that she has carried out by herself in past years. These include collecting flowering bromeliads from donors and delivering them to the school where they will be used as living models. Collecting the finished student art work from the school for delivery to the show early Thursday. This year the show takes place while schools are on Spring Break, so the work will have to be collected early and stored in a safe location for a week. When the show is broken down on Sunday, someone will need to collect the work again, for delivery back to the school. During setup (Thursday), we need several volunteers to help log the student works in and help hang the works on the display boards. This is just a broad outline, if you are able to help, please contact Sharon for more details.

Catering: Chair Sandy Roth This committee is responsible for providing food for volunteers and judges throughout the show. A considerable amount of work, such as planning menus and purchases, is also required for at least a few days before the show. People are needed on every day of the show, but the greatest number of people is needed on Friday. On Friday, a coffee and pastry offering is set out early in the morning for volunteers and judges. Once judging starts, the room is set up for a Judge's Luncheon (volunteers are included in this also). After the afternoon judging session starts, the room is cleaned and operations move the Sandy's house where preparations for the Judge's and Volunteers Dinner Party are completed. Please see Sandy for details.

Classification: Current chair Alan Herndon

Clerks: Chair Maureen Adelman Clerks are needed during Judging on Friday. In the morning, Ribbon Judging is carried out. Pairs of clerks follow each panel of Judges. These clerks are responsible for assisting the judges who may request that an entry be reclassified and have a new card printed, recording the decision of the judges for each entry - along with any notes the judges may ask to be added to an entry card - and affixing the awarded ribbon to the entry card. After lunch, Major Awards Judging takes place. During this period Clerks help collect the plants eligible for major awards from the show tables and assemble them for additional inspection by the judges. It is basically a lot of moving plants back and forth without confusing the plants that need to be put back on the show tables and the plants that end up on the Head Table. You can volunteer for morning judging only, Maureen can give you details on the number of volunteers

Hospitality/Security: Chair Maureen Adelman. As the name suggests, volunteers on this committee perform two major functions. First, these volunteers help visitors who are uncertain how to navigate the show find what they are looking for. They can also help visitors with questions about bromeliads (this includes

directing such visitors to persons most able to answer the questions). People acting in this capacity are needed both in the outdoor sales area and in the Garden Room. During the hours the show is open to the public, members of this committee can also provide security in the sense of keeping an eye on what is happening in the show room and in the sales area. A few people willing to sit by the entry gates during Thursday and Friday are also needed. Please see Maureen for more details.

Information Table: This table at the entrance to the show in the Garden Room is the primary point of contact with visitors. It is important to have society members at the table throughout Saturday and Sunday to greet any visitors who come in. There will also be material available on the Information Table that can be offered to visitors who would like to learn more about bromeliads.


