Jason Mellica graduated from the University of Florida with a botany and horticulture degree. He did an internship at Selby Gardens where he learned about Bromeliads. He has been growing and hybridizing Bromeliads for 30 years. He has 169 registered hybrids and many more to register. He has 2 Greenhouses in the South Sarasota Gulf gate area. He is the former President of the Sarasota Bromeliad Society and the current Vice President.

His presentation is called Rise of the Tiger Neoregelia Bromeliads. I will talk about my newest hybrids as seen below. It will be a hands-on presentation. I will bring my newest hybrids and talk about how I made the crosses. I will explain how to hybridize. Will have examples of young seedlings to adults. I will also explain how I grow them including the light, watering, and fertilizing.



In Case You Missed It by Tina Severson

Alex Bello gave a truly impressive slide presentation, he discussed "South FL Tillandsias Hybrids & More". Alex spoke about Hybridizer Steve Correal and Nestor Delria. He showed beautiful Tillandsias that were Hybrids. Alex also metioned that many of our South FL members are also Hybridizers including himself. Our very own Mike Michalski has also taught us how to make Hybrids. Alan Herndon with Tradewinds Tropicals and several others are also known for their Hybrids.

Alex said that Steve Correal spent from morning till sundown working in his garden to separate and hang his tillandsias. He had several homes in which the yards were filled with amazing plants which Alex was fortunate to be able to visit. As seen in the first slide photo below with the title, it shows one of Steve's many backyards.

When asked the best way to hang Tillandsias he shared how Nestor and Steve typically use just a wire, fishing line or string. Alex suggested that we use shallow baskets because you want the offsets to be unobstructed. He recommended using a small wire basket, typically the ones used for Vanda orchids work best and to hang them. Tillandsias can also be mounted on trees both in the sun and in shade. Alex spoke about making a shade house that he does for his special tillandsias out of 60% shade using a car port. He mentioned how his father helped him make it secure and strong by cementing it into the ground.
